## Interfaith Community Shelter at Pete's Place (2801 Cerillos Rd)

- Seasonal overnight shelter available to men and women
- Individuals interested in staying at Pete's Place must either present proof of COVID-19 vaccination OR proof of a recent negative COVID-19 test
- Free testing for COVID-19 is available at the shelter on Thursdays from 4:00pm-5:00pm

## St. Elizabeth's Casa Familia (1604 Berry Ave)

- Casa Familia is available to women, children, and families and is currently open for shelter and connections to more permanent housing options
- Individuals/families interested in staying at Casa Familia must provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination, including boosters

## St. Elizabeth's Men's Shelter (804 Alarid St)

- Available to single men and is currently open for shelter and connections to more permanent housing options
